
## Nixon and the 1970's Notes

- > As he took office, he moved to get the US out of Vietnam... Vietnamization.
- > Environmental Protection Agency: Regulated water and air pollution, toxic waste, pesticides and radiation
- > Endangered Species Act: Required wildlife services to list and protect endangered species

## **Nixon's Cold War Foreign Policy**

- Detente: Improved relations between US and Soviets.
- ♣ Real reason Nixon visited China? make Russia jealous so they would negotiate. (SALT: Strategic Arms Limitations Talks)
- O NIXON'S RIGHT HAND MAN... HENRY KISSENGER.
- o White House Plumbers: secret investigators to stop information leaks.
- Watergate Scandal: "Plumbers" working on Nixon's re-election Nixon broke into the Democrat Election Headquarters to wiretap phones; caught and Nixon tried to cover up the break in.
- Nixon resigns so that he wouldn't be removed from office by impeachment.
  - Gerald Ford was a nice guy and the perfect President to follow Nixon. However...
  - He pardoned Nixon in order to close the matter,
    Christian compassion and let the country move on.
  - Cost Ford the next election!

## 1970's President Jimmy Carter



- ❖ 1973 Oil Crisis? 1973, Yom Kippur War broke out between Israel and other Arab nations. US helped keep Israeli military supplied (Soviet Union did the same for the other side). In response,
- ❖ OPEC initiated an oil embargo (caused the price of oil to go way up.)



- CAMP DAVID ACCORDS: (Carter's greatest accomplishment) Carter negotiates peace between Israel and Egypt
- ❖ Prior to 1953, Iran was a constitutional monarchy. The US and Great Britain orchestrated a coup that overthrew the democracy and helped the Shah (king) become a dictator. 1979, this came back to bite the US.... revolution overthrew American-friendly Shah for anti-American Ayatollah Khomeini.
- ❖ IRANIAN HOSTAGE CRISIS: 66 Americans were taken as hostages at the US embassy in Tehran, Iran and held for 444 days. Rescue mission fails, once Reagan takes office, the hostages are finally released.
- > Three Mile Disaster: 1979 nuclear meltdown in Pennsylvania; no nuclear plants built since
