- In the 1930s, Hitler and the Nazis made **anti-Semitism** (_____ of Jews and Arabs) a center point of their campaign to control _____
- How did they succeed in this?
 - **Stirred up hatred of the Jews** partially in order → **gave Germans a common enemy**
 - Hitler also **hoped to create a unified Germany** in which **all people would be of similar mind and body**
 - This meant getting **rid of people like the Jews**, either by _____, **voluntary emigration**, or **death**
