d Adopted Chinese culture and Confucianism

- d Buddhist sects allowed to develop
- d Created new government structure:
 - -17 Article Constitution
 - -Highly Confucian
 - Focused on morals to be expected of government officials and subjects
 - Ensure smooth running state
 - -Emperor ruled with absolute authority
 - One of earliest moral dictatorial documents





- d Arts & literature of China flourished
- d Elaborate court life [highly refined]
- d Personal diaries
 - h<u>The Pillow Book</u> by Sei Shonagon [10c] hStory of court life
- d First novel
 - hThe Tale of Genji by Lady Murasaki Shikibu h[1000 pgs.+]
- d Moving away from Chinese models in religion, arts, and government
