


Xuanzang (602-644)

► 7th century Buddhist monk

Purpose was to find true Buddhist scriptures in India

Traveled on Silk Road, 629-645




Xuanzang (602-644)

converted pirates who tried to rob him

Importance: help understand Buddhism and cultures along Silk Road

Marco Polo (1254-1324)


- Born in Venice to wealthy trading family
- Traveled with father and uncle to China



Marco Polo (1254-1324)


Employed by Kublai Khan (Mongol ruler) for 17 years

Importance: sparked European interest in the East; however...



Ibn Btutta (1304-1368)

- Arab scholar
- ▶ Born in Morocco
- Visited Spain, Anatolia, West and East Africa, Arabia, Iraq, Persia, Central and Southeast Asia, India, China



Ibn Btutta (1304-1368)

Critical of Islam on the frontier

Importance: illustrate vast expanse of Islamic civilization, never an "outsider"
